



Limeades for LearningSM is national partnership between SONIC and DonorsChoose.org to support public school teachers across the country. From August 30 through September 30, 2010 anyone can go online and vote for their favorite teacher's classroom project at www.limeadesforlearning.com. SONIC will donate more than \$500,000 to the projects that receive the most votes between those dates.

How can I be eligible for Limeades for Learning funding?

To be eligible for Limeades for Learning funding, you must 1) be a U.S. public school teacher; 2) register at DonorsChoose.org; 3) and select the "SONIC Teacher" affiliation during the registration process.

Voting for classroom projects begins on August 30 and ends September 30, so teachers must have a project posted during this timeframe to be eligible for funding.

To be eligible for SONIC / Limeades for Learning Funding, please submit your project by August 15.

- U.S. public school teacher
- Register as SONIC Teacher within your DC.org account
- Submit your project by August 15
- SONIC will fund a maximum of \$600 per project for those receiving the most votes

How To Qualify For This Funding

Log in to your DonorsChoose.org account AND register as a "SONIC Teacher" (if you don't have an account, public school teachers register at www.DonorsChoose.org.)

Submit a project request by August 15. We recommend your request be for materials costing \$400 or less to earn full funding through Limeades for Learning.
